



## Admissions Criteria 2022

Both paragraphs 3 and 5 of the oversubscription criteria make reference to regular church attendance. Liverpool Diocese, on behalf of the governing board, successfully applied to the Office of the Schools Adjudicator for the following variation to our published criteria.

*In the event that during the period specified for attendance at worship the church has been closed for public worship and has not provided alternative premises for that worship, the requirements of these arrangements in relation to attendance will only apply to the period when the church or alternative premises have been available for public worship*

At the meeting of the Admissions Committee held on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2021 governors agreed to disregard confirmation of attendance at worship for those months that St Peter's church was partially closed for worship during 2020 and 2021.

Sunday services resumed at St Peter's on Easter Sunday, 4<sup>th</sup> April 2021. Between 20<sup>th</sup> July 2020 and 11<sup>th</sup> April confirmation of attendance at worship was emailed to parents by Rev Grey, from 11<sup>th</sup> April attendance cards were stamped. It is the responsibility of parents and guardians to submit all evidence (stamped cards and copies of emails) in support of an application for a place at St Peter's when applying for a school place.
